**TIMBER COVE COUNTY WATER DISTRICT
ORDINANCE NO. 2021-001
ORDINANCE OF THE TIMBER COVE COUNTY WATER DISTRICT ADOPTING A NEW
WATER RATE STRUCTURE**

WHEREAS, on August 1, 2017, the District adopted 2017 Ordinance No. 2017-001 AMENDED from resolution 2015-001 which continued its base rate of \$65.00 per month, and established a new variable rate of \$0.09 per gallon of water used; and,

WHEREAS, since this time, through efficiencies gained by making improvements to the District's system, the District has been able to reduce its operating costs; and

WHEREAS, the District desires to drop its variable rate from \$0.09 per gallon to \$0.07 per gallon; and,

WHEREAS, the District believes the new variable rate will still raise adequate revenue for the District; and,

WHEREAS, if by reason of drought or increases in District costs require the District to raise the variable rate back to \$0.09 per gallon, the District desires to reserve this right.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED THAT:

1. Effective August 1, 2021 the new variable rate for each residential customer shall be \$0.07 per gallon.
2. The \$65.00 base rate shall remain the same.
3. The base rate and the new variable rate shall be collected and used in the same manner as set forth in 2017 Ordinance No. 2017-001 AMENDED from resolution 2015-001.
4. The District Board reserves the right to move the variable rate back up to the current maximum of \$0.09 per gallon if conditions warrant the increase.
5. The variable rate may increase to \$.09 per gallon for the general public if a Stage 2 Conservation Notice is issued.
